



2010-11 Revelstoke Mountain Resort Ambassador Pass Program

Objective

The Ambassador Pass program is a joint program offered through the Revelstoke Mountain Resort to Chamber business members. This program is to help local businesses recruit and retain valuable employees through the winter season. The flexibility of the pass to transfer it means businesses can purchase a set number and hold them until the season when they can be assigned to full time staff and offer many creative ways such as an incentive or benefit for employment with that company. With the business owning the pass it may be revoked or transferred should an employee leave the company and will aid in finding a new full time staff member. Standard season pass terms and conditions apply.

Purchasing

Owners or Managers are only permitted to authorize passes for full time staff. Managers are to write a letter of introduction for each employee. Each employee must present a current paystub to Revelstoke Mountain Resort at the time of pass pick up.

The Ambassador Pass cost is \$699 each plus HST and is only available until November 1, 2010.

All contracts must be presented to the Revelstoke Chamber of Commerce for approval along with a completed RMR season pass application form. Credit card and cheque payments can be attached to the application form. If paying by cash or debit, RMR will contact each business directly once applications have been approved.

Refunds will not be given to passes already purchased at any other rate.

Requirements

Training Sessions

Revelstoke Mountain Resort will provide training sessions to Chamber business members. Scheduling will be coordinated by RMR and each business. Training sessions will start October 15th, 2010. Sessions are to be between 30 – 45 minutes in length and will require staff to answer a questionnaire at the end of the presentation. Questions must be answered correctly to qualify for the Ambassador Pass.

Event Participation

Each Company must participate in an event at Revelstoke Mountain Resort. Events schedule TBA. Hours of participation must be a minimum of 4 hours. Failure to attend scheduled events will result in a suspension of pass privileges.

Participation activities include but are not limited to:

- Greeter and information (on event days)
- Registration assistant
- Set up and take down crew
- Dummy Downhill participant
- Stoke to Spoke participant
